RULES

- The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current *Racing Rules of Sailing*. The rules of PHRF- LO, including, that handicapping system shall serve as the class rules for boats racing PHRF.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- Open to boats eighteen (18) feet in length and up
- Entries will be divided into PHRF Spinnaker Fleets, PHRF Non Spinnaker Fleets (Fun Race) Junior races to be held at CYC Friday evening
- Three (3) entries are required to constitute a division in a Fleet
- A current PHRF LO Rating Certificate is required. If one is not available, a rating will be assigned.
- Entry Fee of \$50.00 if received before July 19, 2010, after July 19, 2010 fee will be \$60.00.

- Registration may be completed also on Saturday, August 7th between 0730-0900 at Regatta Headquarters in Sackets Harbor.
- A skipper's meeting will be held at 0915 hours on race day, August 7, 2010 at Regatta Headquarters in Sackets Harbor.

DOCKING

- Free docking is available at the Sackets Harbor Village Dock and at Navy Point Marine for August 6th and August 7th. Rafting of boats may be required.

WARNING SIGNAL

- The warning signal for the first race will be made at 1030 hours on Saturday August 7th.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- Sailing Instructions will be available at Regatta Headquarters in Sackets Harbor during registration on August 7th.

RACE SCHEDULE and SCORING

- Up to four (4) races are planned. One race will constitute a series.
- Scoring for one-design fleets will be in accordance with the Low Point System except no score will be excluded. Scoring for PHRF Fleets will be in accordance with the PHRF-LO Handicapping System. No races will be excluded. This changes RRS 89.3, and Appendix A2.

PRIZES

- Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each division and to the "Overall Winner" of the PHRF Spinnaker Fleet.
- The "Overall Winner" of the PHRF Spinnaker Fleet is eligible to compete in the 2011 National Hospice Regatta Alliance Championship.

- On the water "Race Announcements" will be made by VHF radio.
